• North Valley Chinese School is moving to a new location

In order to maintain the high quality of our programs and continue to offer small classes and excellent low teacher to student ratio, North Valley Chinese School Board of Directors, after careful consideration, has approved two measures for the coming school year, starting this September:

1. A move of our school to reduce facility lease expense
2. A minimal adjustment to our tuition from the current \$350 per school year to \$375, which translates to only about a 40-cent increase per hour.

Our new location is at the San Jose campus of Milpitas Christian School. The address is 3435 Birchwood Lane, San Jose, CA 95132. The School has good size classrooms, wireless Internet access, and computer projector in the classrooms. It is only about 2 miles from our current address and is located in Berryessa Union School District and the same zip code. At this new campus, North Valley Chinese School will continue the tradition of small classes taught by enthusiastic and qualified teachers, providing our students an attractive environment for learning Mandarin and Chinese Culture.
