• Campus safety

Campus safety is always our priority. All parents are expected to share campus patrol duties. • An Accident in Campus

On Sept 18, a student got into an accident in our campus. The student was running and hit his head on a post at basketball/volley ball courts. The student was taken to hospital and got over 10 stitches on his forehead. The student is fine now. When the accident happened, the boy's parents used his cell phone to call 911, however, the 911 emergency service was not able to identify the accident location. The ambulance didn't come within 10 minutes, so the parent had to take the student to hospital by himself. From this experience, please note the following:

- Remind students to be careful when they play at the basketball/volley ball courts. There are many posts in that area.
- Milpitas Christian School has two campuses and we are at San Jose Campus. The school address is 3435 Birch Lane, San Jose.
- Using a telephone inside the classroom will be easier for 911 Emergency services to identify your location, but you need to dial 9 first. So you should dial --- 9 911--- instead of 911
